



The Logics of Iran towards it's uncompromising Nuclear Policy

Abstract

The Nuclear issue of Iran has become a political discussion of significance in both Iran and western countries. A considerable disjunction emerges between the political views of Iranians and that of the west. The Iranian people are almost unified on the point that Iran is entitled to nuclear sovereignty over civilian nuclear power and has denied that it has had a nuclear weapons program, while western countries feel the program has hidden intension of nuclear weapons. The efforts of negotiation led by the EU and UN have so far failed to yield satisfactory results. After the referral of Iran's nuclear issue to the United Nation Security Council in particular, Iran has been following an uncompromising policy towards its nuclear program. Iran claimed that the use of nuclear power is its sovereign right. It is also from the demands of national security and realistic politics. Historical experiences also make a strong impact on Iran's uncompromising nuclear policy. It is also consistent with the principles of Islamic Revolution of Iran in 1979. Focusing on the nuclear ambition of Iran this article mainly tries to discover the principal logics of Iran's uncompromising nuclear policy. The paper also tries to explore the possibility of the potential cooperation on the nuclear issue of Iran.
